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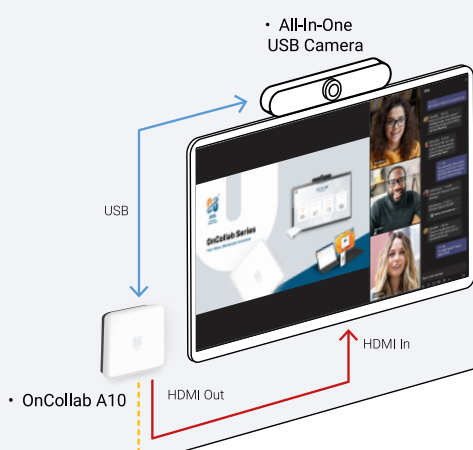
Introduction & Key Features

What is MTR Auto-Switch?

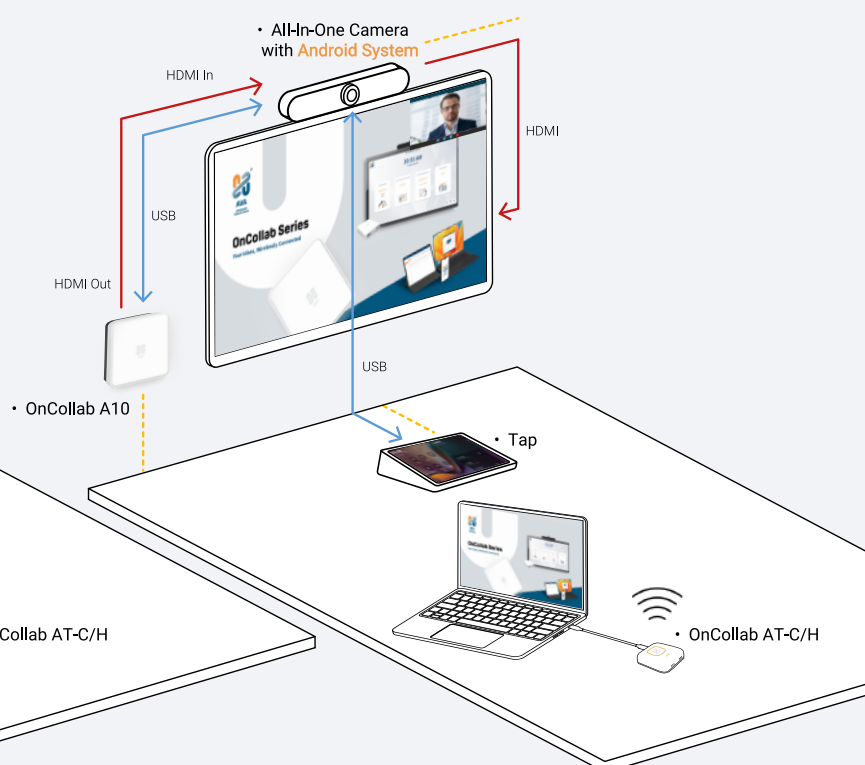
Microsoft Teams Rooms (MTR) is a video conferencing solution built around the Microsoft Teams platform. It supports both Android and Windows-based systems and is available in modular (camera, microphone, display) or all-in-one device setups. An MTR license is required for use.

The OnCollab A10 integrates seamlessly with Android-based MTR-certified devices, enabling effortless switching between **MTR Mode** and **BYOM (Bring Your Own Meeting) Mode**. This allows for a more flexible and user-friendly hybrid meeting experience.

Key Features

One Click Share for Room and Remote

Eliminate the need for HDMI and USB cables. With one-click wireless sharing, content can be shown in-room and to remote participants via Teams or any other conferencing app.

Smart Auto-Switch

The system automatically detects and transitions between MTR and BYOM modes. No manual reconfiguration needed, ensuring uninterrupted meeting flow.

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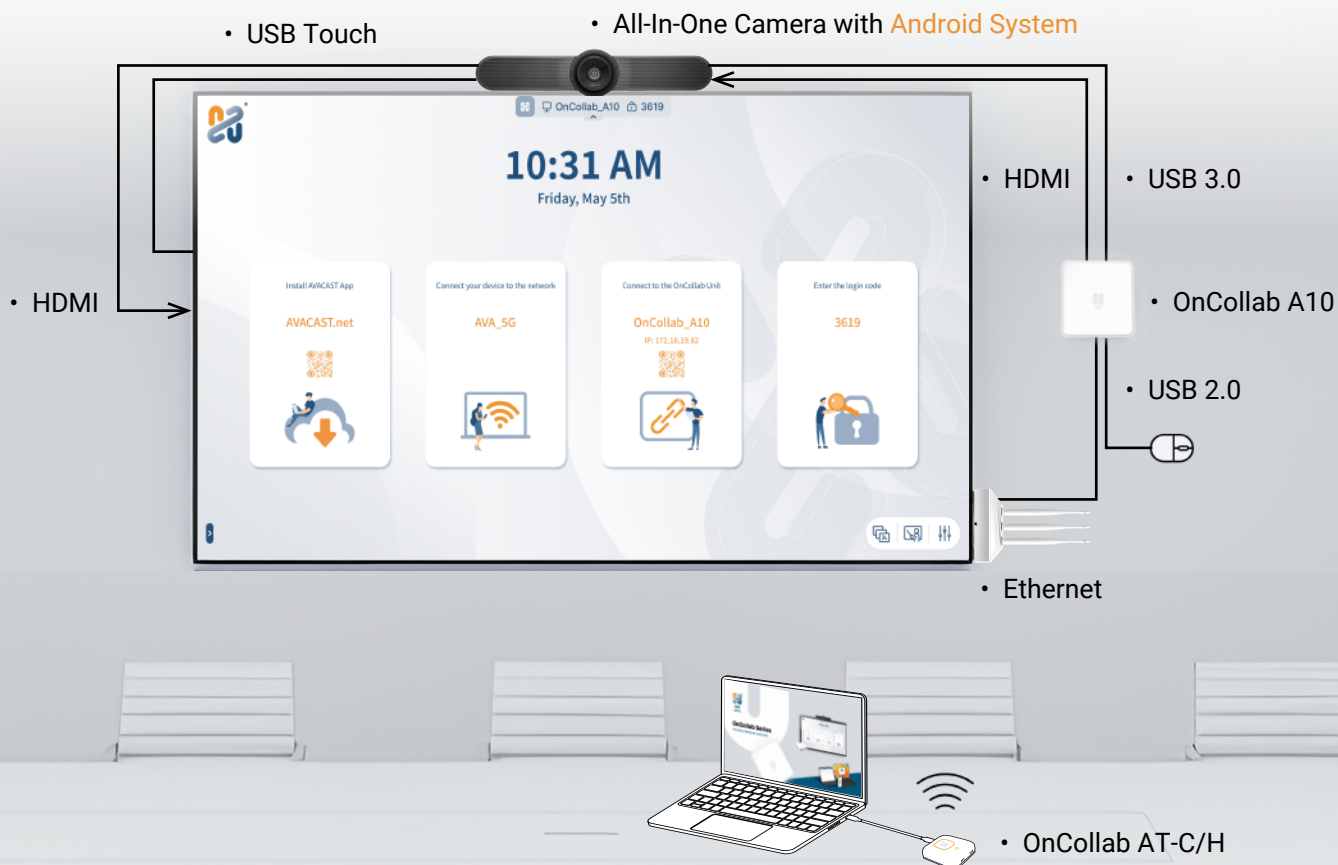
Getting Started

Setup: Connecting A10 to Your MTR Camera

1. Connect a USB cable from the MTR camera to A10's USB 3.0 port.
2. Connect A10's HDMI OUT to the HDMI IN on your MTR camera.
3. Connect the HDMI OUT from your MTR camera to the TV or display.
4. Connect the display's touchscreen USB cable to the MTR camera.
5. Plug a mouse into A10's USB 2.0 port.

Important Note

1. If set up correctly, the A10 main screen will appear on your TV screen.
2. Before enabling MTR Mode, make sure your AT-C and AT-H are already paired.
You cannot pair or re-pair them while in MTR Mode.



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Enabling/Disabling MTR Auto-Switch

☒ Enabling MTR Auto-Switch

1. Use the mouse to click the settings icon at the bottom-right.
2. In the settings menu, disable the login code.
3. Click "Version Number" 3 times.
4. In the popup menu, check "Enable MTR Mode".
5. Open settings again and click "Apply".
6. The device will restart in MTR Mode.

☐ Disabling MTR Auto-Switch

1. Shake the mouse for 5 seconds to return to the A10 main screen.
2. Click the settings icon at the bottom-right.
3. Click "Version Number" 3 times.
4. In the popup menu, uncheck "Enable MTR Mode".
5. Open settings again and click "Apply".
6. The device will restart in normal mode.

In MTR Mode

1. The screen will default to the MTR camera interface.
2. To switch back to A10's main screen, move the mouse continuously for 5 seconds.
